




Montana

Arrival: May 18, 2022 | Departure: May 21, 2022

Day 1 / Arrival Day (May 18) | Whitefish & Columbia Falls



After a morning of flying, lunch awaits upon our arrival in downtown [Whitefish](#), a charming mountain resort town that is home to [Whitefish Mountain Resort](#). After lunch, spend some time walking downtown Whitefish and exploring the boutique shops, galleries and cafes.

5 p.m.: Head to Columbia Falls, check into [Roam Beyond](#), and settle into your own private roaming cabin set amongst the tall timbers.

7 p.m.: BBQ dinner provided by Roam Beyond as we enjoy the summer camp feel and amazing views of the Swan Mountains.

Day 2 (May 19) | Glacier National Park



9 a.m.: We will visit one of Western Montana's cutest downtowns – [Bigfork](#), recognized as one of the 100 best small arts towns in the U.S. We will enjoy a hearty breakfast and peruse Electric Avenue, and the one-lane bridge that makes this town so charming.

11:30 a.m.: Glacier National Park awaits. We will make a quick stop in West Glacier and Apgar Village for great photo opportunities. Lake McDonald from Apgar Village is the most photographed spot in all of Glacier.

1:30 p.m.: Today's adventure includes a guided e-biking experience with [Glacier Guides](#) on the famous Going-to-the-Sun Road in [Glacier National Park](#). Everyone can go at their own pace, and dinner is included along the route. Dan Hansen from Explore Whitefish will join us.

8 p.m.: Check into [Clark Farm Silos](#) and experience these amazing grain silos that have been converted into quaint lodging options. Enjoy s'mores around the firepit and gazing at the amazing stars.

Day 3 (May 20) | West Glacier



9:30 a.m.: Load up our luggage and head to Glacier Highland for breakfast in West Glacier, followed by exploring the [Crown of the Continent Discovery Center](#) in West Glacier and learning about the protection of Glacier National Park and the surrounding regions distinct values.

12:30–3:30 p.m.: Today's adventure includes a 2-hour horseback ride out of the West Glacier Corral with [Swan Mountain Outfitters](#), through lodgepole pine forests along with larch and cottonwood trees and views of Strawberry Mountain.

4:30 p.m.: Refresh at this evening's accommodations, [Hampton Inn Kalispell](#).

7:15 p.m.: Our final dinner together will be in downtown Kalispell at [Mercantile Steak](#), one of Kalispell's new fine dining establishments just off of Main Street. Dawn Jackson from Discover Kalispell will join us.
